AND I COULD TAP HERE, AND HE COULD HEAR ON HIS RADIO. AND THIS WAS WITHOUT AN AERIAL. AND HE MANAGED TO FIND A FREQUENCY THAT IT ENDED UP ON. AND WE DIDN'T KNOW ENOUGH CODE TO SAY VERY MUCH OTHER THAN SOS AND A FEW MORE THINGS. WE NEVER LEARNT THE WHOLE CODE. WE DIDN'T WANT TO DO IT TOO MUCH BECAUSE YOU KNEW IF YOU KEPT ON DOING IT PEOPLE WOULD BE ROUND FROM THE POST OFFICE, BECAUSE THEY'D LISTEN TO YOU AND TRACK YOU DOWN AND IT WAS AGAINST THE POST OFFICE LAW OR SOMETHING!"
